Antelope Valley Pagan Pride Day: September 22, 2007

We are proud to announce the **Sixth Annual Pagan Pride Day in the Antelope Valley**. This year will prove to be even more successful than the last. Pagan Pride Day is a wonderful opportunity for you to become more actively involved in the Pagan Community by helping us educate the general public about Paganism, while introducing your business to area Pagans who may not be aware of it. Not to mention, that your participation helps Antelope Valley Pagan Pride Day and helps our event to keep going. Last year we had approximately 400 attendees and collected over 500 pounds of food.

This year's event will be held for the second time at Poncitlan Square in Palmdale on September 22, 2007. It is located at *38315 9th Street East, Palmdale, California 93550*. The event is completely outdoors. Booth spaces are 10'x10'. Vendors will need to provide their own tables and pop-up tents. Tents are not required, but highly recommended if you want shade. The Antelope Valley can be very warm, and dry, and also quite windy. The City of Palmdale asks that we secure our sunshades with sandbags or weights. The event will be from 10:00 am – 5:00 pm. Vendors will be allowed to start setting up at 8:00 am. Please do not arrive any earlier. You will need to be completely torn down by 6pm.

Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. You may request a preference, but we cannot guarantee you will be assigned your choice. Space assignments will be based according to date of application & payment received, and date payment clears. There will be no electricity provided for this event. If you must have electricity, you will need to bring your own generator, provided it is muffled. Please note on your application if you plan to bring a generator as we will need to place you away from any workshops where noise would interfere with hearing the speakers for the workshop. Best to plan to do without if you can. Should you wish to have a site larger than 10X10, you can double the size of your space for an additional \$25 fee, once again, please contact Daniel if you are considering this.

If check does not clear, a \$25 fee will be applied. Payment, including \$25 charge, must be paid either by money order, cashier's check, or cash, prior to the day of the event. If your check does not clear two years in a row, you will be required to pay fees by money order, cashier's check, or cash for future events.

Please note: If you are sharing space, each vendor is required to submit a signed completed application and all applications MUST be received together. On the top each application submitted, the following should be noted: "SHARING SPACE WITH *insert name of vendor(s)*"

Vendor fees are \$35 plus a donation item to our raffle, if received before August 15, 2007, and \$45 plus a donation item to our raffle thereafter. Each individual sharing the booth is required to donate an item to our raffle, however; only one fee will be assessed per booth.

The vendor fee is not tax deductible, however, any amount over \$75 or any additional donation items will be tax deductible and a receipt will be provided. Any additional monies or donation items above what is required are also greatly appreciated.

In the past, I have had several smaller, individual vendors who were unable to participate due to the costs involved. This year, while I cannot guarantee a match, I am willing to keep a list of the names of vendors who would like to participate, but can only do so by sharing a booth. I will **not** hold spaces for those waiting for a match, and there is no guarantee that a space will be available even if a match is found. If this option interests you, please email Daniel at gwahir1@verizon.net with your name, contact number and type of business so that you can be added to the list. Please remember this option does not guarantee you a space in the festival, and is only available as an alternative to not participating at all. I still encourage you to find your own business partner with whom to share if this is the only way you can participate in our event. Our arrangement with the City of Palmdale requires that all vendors either hold a City of Palmdale business license, or are resellers within the state they reside. If you do not have a license, consider sharing a booth with someone who does. We want as many vendors that are pagan to come and participate but we are bound by the rules required by the City.
